

PRIVACY POLICY

Respecting the confidentiality of user data is one of the fundamental principles of the work of NODDINGTON TECHNOLOGIES LIMITED (hereinafter referred to as the "Company" / "We"). Our Privacy Statement and our methods of work are aimed at processing the information you provide in an appropriate and lawful manner and at ensuring its confidentiality, safety and availability.

This Privacy Statement is a complete statement of the privacy policy of the information you submit and applicable to the activities of the Company. The Statement explains how you provide information, as well as how and for what purpose we use, transfer and protect it. - all reasonable steps must be taken to ensure that information is promptly deleted or corrected;
- information is not subject to disclosure and must be stored in a manner that ensures its proper protection;
- information is not subject to transfer to third parties, except in cases where such transfer is necessary in order for us to be able to provide you with services;
- You have the right to access information, to change or delete it, to restrict or object to its processing, and you have the right to transfer it.

Collection of information

If you have an intention to use Our services, we may ask You to provide information so that You can carry out your work, provide your services and improve them. The information may be transmitted by you through our website: evido.one or other electronic or software solutions supported by us. We process the information you provide only to the extent necessary to achieve strictly defined, unambiguous and lawful purposes, or for a purpose required to be achieved by the laws of the country in which we operate.

Use of cookies

Our cookies do not contain information that can directly or indirectly identify a person. We automatically collect certain information through the use of cookies and tracking tools, such as an Internet Protocol address (IP address); browser type; Internet Service Provider (ISP); pages with which the user entered the site and from which he left the site; files viewed on our website (e.g. HTML pages, images); Operating system Date and time stamp and/or click statistics to analyze general trends and to manage the site.
